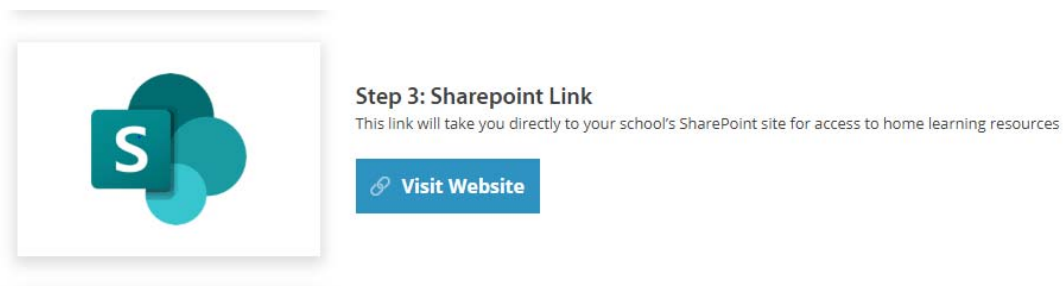


Dear Parent/Carer,

Following the parental feedback on the structure of the work on SharePoint we have reviewed our system to streamline how students access work. One document has been created for each day of the week, which each contain wellbeing tips and five learning sessions. By working through one document each day students will have the opportunity to complete work from all subjects they would normally have on their timetable.

All of these resources have been put on a website that has been created to facilitate this. Your child will access their school work through a dedicated page on the academy website:

To access their school work on the SharePoint website they will need their email address and their password (which is what they usually use to log in to the school system). Most students should have a sticker in their planner with this information.

The work is designed to complement the weekly assignments which are accessed by students using www.senecalearning.com. Students have received email instructions with a unique access code for their year group to allow them to access their assignments. The assignments contain information for students to read followed by quizzes to check their understanding.
